

Freestyle 4 Patch

Baby: 58" x 72" • Lap: 72" x 93" • Double 79" x 100"

For this fun and easy 4 patch quilt, begin by choosing the required number of feature fabric prints, (see "A" requirements below), fat quarters or 1/4 cuts can also be used. Fabric "A" is for the large 7-1/2" blocks, suitable for small to large floral prints, theme fabric with scenes, people, animals or juvenile prints, etc. For a really scrappy look, use a different fabric for each 7-1/2" feature block!

Once the feature fabric has been chosen, select the required number of, small-scale fabric, for the B and C, 4 patch prints. Fabric, "B" & "C" prints should each represent a different color which compliment the feature "A" fabrics.

The quilt pictured was made using a large purple & green floral print for fabric "A". Small-scale green tone on tone prints were used for fabric "B". Small-scale tone on tone purple prints were used for fabric "C".
