

# Morning Pansies

Finished Size: 55" x 69",

A scrappy variety of pastel green & blue create a perfect background for the pansy appliques in this quilt. Designed with fat quarters in mind, (quarter yard cuts also work), yardage requirements are easy - for every block you will need the equivalent of one fat quarter, (or quarter yard).

Pattern instructions are provided for "raw edge" appliqué, however, fusible web appliqué with a simple buttonhole stitch will work nicely as will traditional hand appliqué.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Background blocks:

12 fat quarters, (1/4 yd cuts will also work in place of fat quarters).

Pansies:

For the pansies petals, an assortment of 6 different purple fat quarters, (or 1/4 yd cuts), provide a nice variety, however if you are using scraps, please refer to the following requirements:

Large petals, purple: (22), 5" x 5" squares

Medium petals, purple: (33), 4" x 4" squares

Small petals, purple: (33), 3" x 3" squares

Pansy center, yellow (11), 2" x 2" squares

Pansy leaves, green: (22), 3" x 4" rectangles

Inner border: 1/3 yd

Outer border: 1 yd

Backing 3-1/2 yd

Binding 1/2 yd

Supplies:

Pattern: Morning Pansies By Karla Alexander

Fabric according to pattern

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall
